



Application for El Sol Foundation American Dream Scholarship

Four years ago, the El Sol Foundation initiated the El Sol American Dream Scholarship Program. It supports high school students who have been accepted and have agreed to attend a four-year university or college. The American Dream Scholarship will provide gap funding; that is, colleges costs that are not funded by student receipt of gifts, grants and family resources.

Scholarship Threshold Requirements

- Completed 8th grade at and graduated from El Sol Science and Arts Academy in Spring 2018
- Eligible to participate in the free and reduced lunch program or if in a private or charter school meets family or individual income requirements similar in kind to the eligibility for the free and reduced lunch program.
- Formal Acceptance letter from College or University and Student Agreement to attend such college or university

Scholarship Review Criteria

- Academic Track Record (2.7 or above GPA average), leadership qualities in high school, community service achievements

Selection

Student applicants who meet threshold requirements will be selected for scholarships on the basis of El Sol Foundation review of **academic merit** (2.7 GPA or higher), **leadership qualities and community service achievements** during their four years in high school. All finalists will be asked to participate in an interview with El Sol Foundation Board members before Board selection.

Deadline

Please submit your application by May 20th, 2022, no later than 5:00pm. Notification of Foundation decisions will be emailed to students on or before June 24, 2022.

Application Requirements

We are pleased to provide you with the El Sol American Dream Scholarship Application. If you are interested in being considered for the American Dream Scholarship, we request that you complete the attached application and submit required materials by May 20th no later than 5:00pm.

- **Completed Application Form** (attached)
- **High School Transcript**
- **Essays (2)**

Essay 1: The first essay should briefly describe your background and your American Dreams concerning your future career. You should also identify the two or three people who have influenced you the most up to the present time (and why).

Essay 2: The second essay should describe what you believe you will gain from a college education in terms of your future career.

Each essay should not exceed 650 words. They will be judged on content and legibility.

- **Letters of Reference (2)**

Each applicant is asked to submit two letters of reference. At least one of the letters should be from a high school teacher in one of the applicant's STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics) classes. The second letter may be from a non-STEAM teacher (eg. history, civics) or a community leader who is knowledgeable about the applicant's leadership qualities and community service.

- **Release of Information Form**

The Release of Information Form, (signed by your parent/guardian), will permit the El Sol Foundation to secure your income eligibility, (defined by free and reduced lunch criteria or if private school or charter school, similar family income numbers), GPA and transcripts from your high school. Please include it as an attachment to your application. **The materials you send to us and those we secure from your school will only be used to determine your eligibility to compete for the El Sol American Dream Scholarship Award and facilitate the Award review process.** The signed release form will not affect your eligibility to participate in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program. Students and their parent/guardian should complete the yellow highlighted areas of the form before asking a high school counselor, administrator, or registrar to complete the blue portion. *Please allow for at least 1 week processing time at your school site.*

- **College Admissions Confirmation**

Please attach a copy of your acceptance letter from your selected College or University and proof of your intent to register or proof of registration deposit (paid/waived) printed from your student portal of your intended College/University.
